

A batch of II M.Sc. Chemistry, I M.Sc. Chemistry and II B.Sc. Chemistry students (49) and 2 faculty visited the KudanKulam Nuclear Power Project (KKNPP). The unit mainly focusing on the generating nuclear power. Mr. Velmail Murugan, Member, Public Awareness Committee addressed the students and introduced about KKNPP. Also, he explained how to reach a safe assembly point if any accident happens in the unit.







"Handmade" is one of the most effective descriptors to help emphasize the quality and uniqueness of a product. Like any other word, though, it comes with baggage and must be used with care. A handicraft, sometimes more precisely expressed as artisanal handicraft or handmade, is any of a wide variety of types of work where useful and decorative objects are made completely by hand or by using only simple tools. It is a traditional main sector of craft and applies to a wide range of creative and design activities that are related to making things with one's hands and skill, including work with textiles, moldable and rigid materials, paper, plant fibers, etc. One of the world's oldest handicraft is Dhokra; this is a sort of metal casting that has been used in India for over 4,000 years and is still used. Usually, the term is applied to traditional techniques of creating items (whether for personal use or as products) that are both practical and aesthetic. Handicraft industries are those that produce things with hands to meet the needs of the people in there.
